- The highest sale value during April 2020 was registered in <u>Al Hudaiba</u> for Residential Investment Land Built (Transfer) with a value of AED 3 million.

In Table (1), we notice a <u>rapid increase</u> in Real Estates Volume in April 2021, by 360% compared to April 2020. An 35% <u>increase</u> in Sales Number in April 2021 compared to April 2020. We also notice a <u>steep rise</u> by 177% in Market Value of Transfers in April 2021 compared to April 2020, and a <u>dramatic increase</u> in Number of Transfers by 229%. We also notice a <u>sharp increase</u> in Mortgages Value by 142% in April 2021 compared to April 2020, and correspondingly a <u>rapid increase</u> in Number of Mortgages by 445%.
